Port Augusta Hospital	Nurse triage then call GP as needed	Roster of GPs between private GPs, Pika Wiya Aboriginal Health Service. Hospital enforced 1 GP on call for 24 hours, pay a flat fee, may see up to 70 patients AH, often no sleep and then have to attend own practice next day. Have trouble maintaining the roster, as some GPs don't want to be involved anymore. Poor relationship with the hospital. Nurse triage often limited. RFDS deal with remote emergencies.
Quorn Hospital	Nurse triage then call GP as needed	1 GP on call all the time
Hawker Hospital	Nurse triage then call GP as needed	1 GP on call all the time
Leigh Creek Hospital	Nurse triage then call GP as needed	1 locum rotates through the practice fortnightly, on call all the time
Woomera Hospital	Nurse triage then call GP as needed	1 GP on call all the time, has to cover the detention centre
Roxby Downs Hospital	Nurse triage then call GP as needed	2 GPs share roster
