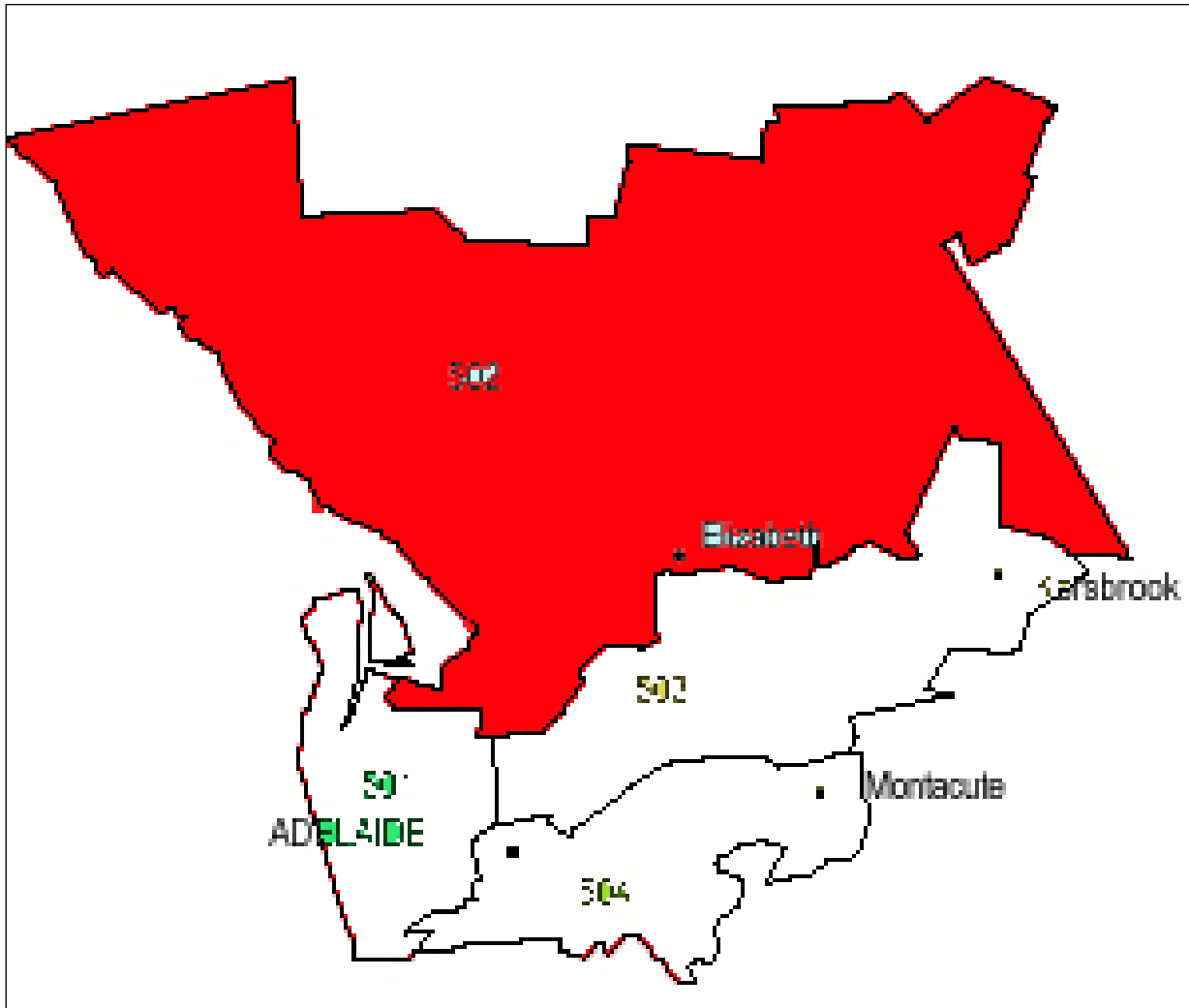
The population of the ANEDGP catchment area has increased by 7.5% in the past 4 years, which is nearly double the increase predicted for metropolitan Adelaide as a whole. This will place more pressure on GPs if there is no growth in the GP workforce.

The Salisbury and Tea Tree Gully areas have the highest predicted growth over the next 15 years for the 70-79 and 80+ age groups across the metropolitan area, which has significant implications for provision of after hours services in the future.

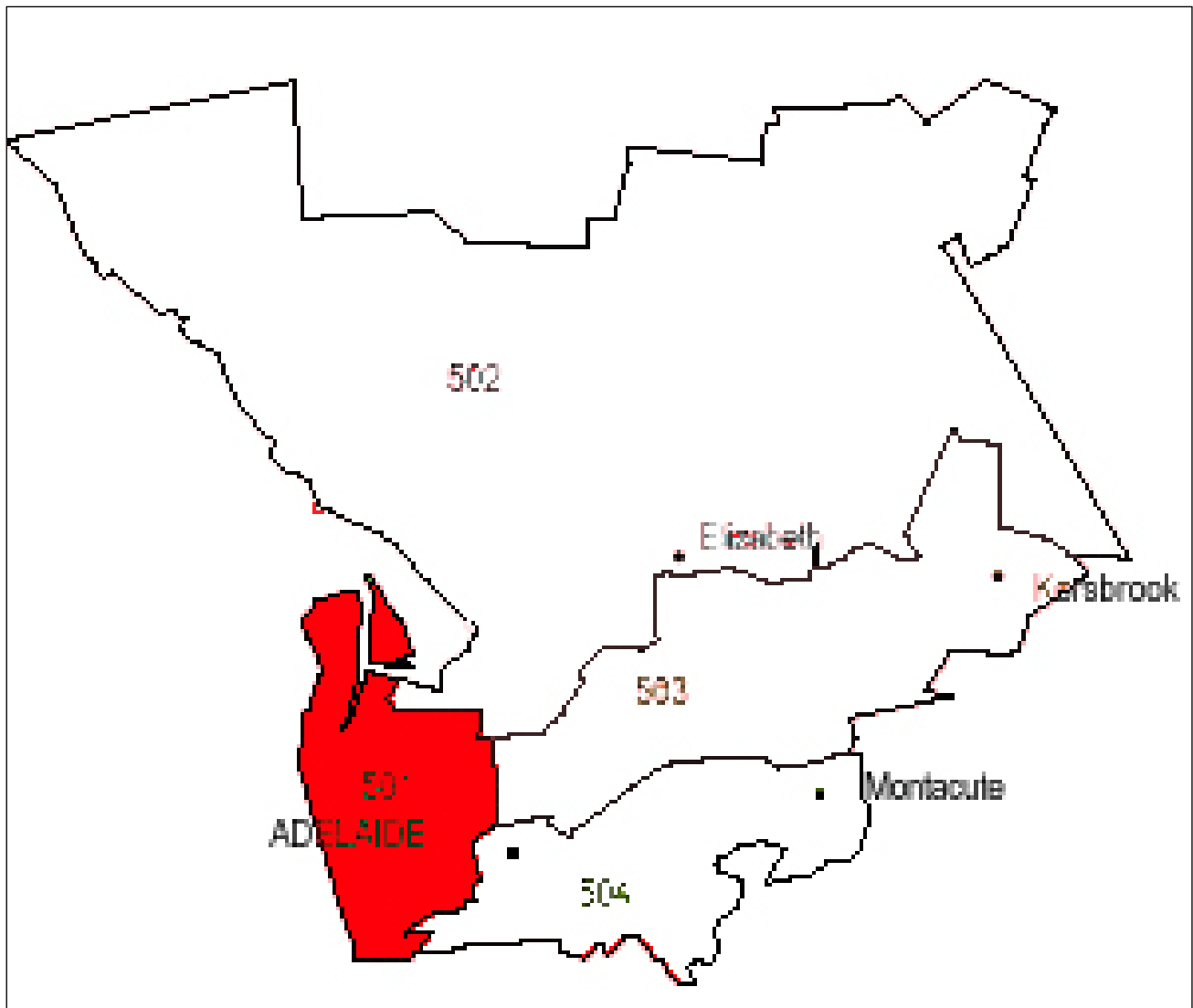
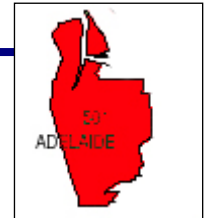
