Statistical Reports

ACIR001A Number of children registered with ACIR

This report provides the user with a count of children currently registered with the ACIR, by locality and age of the child. The report includes options for age breakdown as follows:

- by Scheduled Age, e.g. <3 Months, 3-4 Months;
- by Age Group, e.g. 0 Months, 1 Month, 2 Months; or
- by Birth Date Range, e.g. 01/01/1997 to 31/12/1997.

ACIR002A Number (or percentage) of children who have received valid vaccinations

This report provides the user with a breakdown of children who have received valid vaccinations, by locality and age of the child. The report includes options for breakdown as follows:

Vaccination information:

- the disease vaccinated against, e.g. Diphtheria, Tetanus; or
- the vaccination brand, e.g. IFX, CMX, OPV.

Date type:

- a breakdown by the age calculated as at Current Date (age as at date report produced); or
- a breakdown by the age calculated as at Vaccination date (age as at date the vaccination was given).

Age breakdown:

- by Scheduled Age, e.g. <3 Months, 3-4 Months;
- by Age Group, e.g. 0 Months, 1 Months, 2 Months; or
- by Birth Date Range, e.g. 01/01/1997 to 31/12/1997.

ACIR002B Number of children who have received valid vaccinations, by a selected provider

This report provides the user with a breakdown of the number of valid vaccinations administered by a specified provider. The report includes options for breakdown as follows:

Vaccination information:

- the disease vaccinated against, e.g. Diphtheria, Tetanus; or
- the vaccination brand, e.g. IFX, CMX, OPV.

Date type:

- a breakdown by the age calculated as at Current Date (age as at date report produced); or
- a breakdown by the age calculated as at Vaccination date (age as at date the vaccination was given).

Age breakdown:

- by Scheduled Age, e.g. <3 Months, 3-4 Months; or
- by Age Group, e.g. 0 Months, 1 Months, 2 Months; or
- by Birth Date Range, e.g. 01/01/1997 to 31/12/1997.

ACIR003A Number of children whose parents have withdrawn consent

This report provides a count and percentage of children whose parents have opted out of receiving Child History Statements, consent has been withdrawn from HIC to pass on immunisation details to a third party, or lodged a conscientious objection, by the locality of the child.

In addition, Divisions of General Practice will also be able to produce the report for a particular Division number. The report includes an option for age breakdown as follows:

- by Birth Date Range, e.g. 01/01/1997 to 31/12/1997.

ACIR005A Number of providers who have submitted valid vaccination information to the ACIR

This report provides a count (or a count and percentage) of providers who have submitted valid vaccination information to the ACIR by the provider type and locality of the information provider. The report includes an option for breakdown as follows:

- by Receipt Date Range, e.g. 01/01/2001 to 31/03/2001.

Tick boxes are provided to allow the requestor to select the provider types to be included in the report.

Identified Reports

ACIR011A Due/Overdue Report by locality

Detailed report of children due and/or overdue for immunisation by locality. This report can be broken down by postcode, or a postcode range. This report provides the option to include:

- overdue children, by a specified number of days; or
- due children (includes overdue children); and
- date of birth range.

The output options available include the following:

- child details (including name, address, and overdue status);
- immunisation history of each child (including all vaccines recorded on the ACIR as at the time the report is produced);
- due/overdue antigens (includes antigens, date due, and date overdue for each child on the report);
- provider details (including name, address, and phone number of providers who have given vaccinations to the children reported); and
- Natural Immunity/Medical Contraindication details.

ACIR011B Due/Overdue Report by provider

Detailed report of children due and/or overdue for immunisations by provider. This report may be used to identify children where the provider requesting the report is recorded as the child's last immunising service provider or has immunised the child in the last 12 months. This report provides the option to include:

- overdue children, by a specified number of days; or
- due children (includes overdue children);
- include all children immunised by provider (this is a maximum 12 month date range based on receipt of encounters); and
- date of birth range.

The output options available include the following:

- child details (including name, address and overdue status);

- immunisation history of each child (including all vaccines recorded on the ACIR as at the time the report is produced);
- due/overdue antigens (includes antigens, date due, and date overdue for each child on the report);
- provider details (including name, address, and phone number of providers who have given vaccinations to the children reported); and
- Natural Immunity/Medical Contraindication details.

ACIR015A History Update Report

This report identifies children where the immunisation information or service has been supplied or administered by other providers, within a locality. The information returned in the report can be used by the requestor to ensure that they have up to date and accurate records. The report includes an option for breakdown as follows:

- by Information Date Range, e.g. 01/03/2002 to 31/03/2002.

This report is produced in comma separated format only. The output does not necessarily include the child's complete immunisation history, only those episodes where the information provider or immunising provider (depending on the option selected) was not the requestor. The output options available include the following:

- child details (including name, address and overdue status);
- immunisation history of each child (including all vaccines recorded on the ACIR as at the time the report is produced, where the information provider or immunising provider was not the requester);
- due/overdue antigens (includes antigens, date due, and date overdue for each child on the report);
- provider details (including name, address, and phone number of providers who have given vaccinations to the children reported); and
- Natural Immunity/Medical Contraindication details.

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ACIR016A Provider Contact Details

This report provides a list of providers contact details by locality. This report provides a breakdown by Provider type as follows:

- General Practitioners and General Practices; and/or
- public provider types.

Once the options have been selected by provider type, an option can be selected to produce the report by participation as follows:

- providers who have submitted data to the ACIR;
- providers who have not submitted data to the ACIR; or
- all providers registered.

If the selection is made to include providers who have or have not submitted information to the ACIR; the requestor may input the number of months since information has or has not been submitted to the ACIR. Or the requestor can input a date range in which information was or was not submitted to the ACIR.

The output produced for the selection of:

- General Practitioners and General Practices is provider number, provider registration type, provider name, GPII registered indicator, address, and phone number; or
- public provider types is provider number, provider registration type, provider business name, address, and phone number.

The report is produced in comma separated format only.

ACIR020A GPII Practice Report

This report identifies children assessed for the practice's quarterly GPII Feedback Statement sent to GPII or PIP registered practices. This report is produced after the GPII statements are produced for each GPII/PIP Practice where they have an existing quarterly report request. This report is only available to request for those practices that receive a GPII Feedback Statement in the selected quarter, and where all providers at the practice have signed a Section 46E agreement (Health Insurance Act 1973).

This report can be requested in two ways. Those practices that have access to the ACIR Internet site may request a GPII Practice Report using their

Internet access, which can be downloaded electronically. Or a request can be made for this report to be sent in hardcopy to the practice. For further information regarding this report being produced in hardcopy please call 1800 246 101. Information produced in this report includes the following:

- child details (including name, address and overdue status);
- single visit status (Y = single visit, N = not single visit);
- GPII assessment status (Fully/Not Fully Immunised);
- Immunisation Age Schedule the child is being assessed against;
- The ASVS (Australian Standard Vaccination Schedule) that the child is being assessed against;
- antigen and dose missing to consider the child Fully Immunised for GPII;
- Immunisation history of each child (including all vaccines recorded on the ACIR as at the time the report is produced);
 - vaccinations administered after the last day of the reference period are highlighted with #1 next to the vaccine status; and/or
 - vaccinations processed after the calculation date are highlighted with a #2 next to the vaccine status; and
 - Natural Immunity/Medical Contraindication details.

ACIR021A Due/Overdue Report

The purpose of this report is to enable General Practitioners to actively follow up those children who are classified due/overdue for one or more antigens. The report is produced at the stem level for a General Practitioner (This means that the report will identify children for all current practice locations the GP has when requesting the report).

This report will use information from the Medicare and ACIR databases to determine if a child should be included in a General Practitioner's report. Children who have attended the GP for a Medicare service in the last 12 months will be included where their immunisation history meets the criteria for the report parameters.

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The output options available include the following:

- include children overdue for an immunisation service;
- include children due for an immunisation service;
- include children you have seen for a Medicare service in the last 12 months; and
- date of birth range.

Information produced in this report includes the following:

- child details (including name, address and overdue status);
- immunisation history of each child (including all vaccines recorded on the ACIR as at the time the report is produced);
- due/overdue antigens (includes antigens, date due, and date overdue for each child on the report); and
- Natural Immunity/Medical Contraindication details.

ACIR032A Immunisation coverage rates of practices registered for the GPII as at DDMONCCYY

The purpose of this report is to identify the practices registered for GPII within your division as at the date the report is produced. The report includes the number of Whole Patient Equivalents and GPII coverage rate for each practice for the quarter of the report, and whether or not the practice requested a GPII Practice Report for the two most recent quarters. Only those practices receiving a GPII quarterly feedback statement will be included in the report.

ACIR033A General Practitioners supplying immunisation data to the ACIR as at DDMONCCYY

The purpose of this report is to identify Medicare providers and General Practices in a divisional area supplying data to the ACIR within a specified 12 month period. The requestor may specify postcodes within the Division, or select to include all postcodes attached to the Division. Information produced in this report includes:

- provider details (this includes the providers name and address details).

ACIR034A Practices registered with GPII as at DDMONCCYY

The purpose of this report is to identify the names and addresses of practices registered with the GPII program in a divisional area. The report includes practices with an approved status only.

ACIR035A General Practice Immunisation Incentives Report as at DDMONCCYY

This report identifies children assessed for the Division's quarterly GPII Feedback Statement. The report is produced after the GPII feedback statements are produced for each GPII/PIP Practice where they have an existing quarterly report request.

Information produced in this report includes the following:

- child details (including name, address and overdue status);
- single visit status (Y = single visit, N = not single visit);
- GPII assessment status (Fully/Not Fully Immunised);
- Immunisation Age Schedule the child is being assessed against;
- The ASVS (Australian Standard Vaccination Schedule) that the child is being assessed against;
- antigen and dose missing to consider the child Fully Immunised for GPII;
- Immunisation history of each child (including all vaccines recorded on the ACIR as at the time the report is produced);
 - Vaccinations administered after the last day of the reference period are highlighted with #1 next to the vaccine status; and/or
 - Vaccinations processed after the calculation date are highlighted with a #2 next to the vaccine status;
- provider details (including the provider number, name, address, and phone number); and
- Natural Immunity/Medical Contraindication details.

This report is produced in comma separated format only.

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ACIR036A Due/Overdue Report

Detailed report of children overdue for immunisations in a Divisional area. This report may be used to identify children who are due or overdue for one or more immunisations within the Divisional area.

The output options available include the following;

- children overdue for an immunisation service;
- children due for an immunisation service;
- all children in your Divisional area; and
- date of birth range.

Information produced in this report includes the following:

- child details (including name, address and overdue status);
- immunisation history of each child (including all vaccines recorded on the ACIR as at the time the report is produced);

- due/overdue antigens (includes antigens, date due, and date overdue for each child on the report); and
- Natural Immunity/Medical Contraindication details.

Access Report

ACIR031A Internet Access Statement

This is a monthly statement produced for providers outlining what access their provider number has had to the ACIR Internet site. The statements are automatically produced each month for providers who have accessed the site in the past month, and are mailed out in hardcopy as well as being available to view online. Providers are encouraged to check this statement thoroughly and notify the ACIR of any unauthorised access.
