About the Divisions Network

Australian Divisions of General Practice (ADGP) is the peak national body representing 118 Divisions of General Practice and eight state-based organisations (SBOs) across Australia. About 94 per cent of GPs are members of a local Division of General Practice.

The Divisions Network is a primary cornerstone of Australia's primary health care system. ADGP's key objective is

to promote the health and well-being of Australians through Divisions of General Practice by:

- strengthening the effectiveness and vitality of the general practice sector by leading and supporting the Divisions Network
- advocating for, and representing the network to government, other organisations and the Australian public
- contributing to the development and implementation of national health policy in collaboration with divisions and SBOs
- promoting cooperation and communication with other national organisations in Australia that are working toward excellence in primary health care and general practice
- providing national leadership in health system development.

Taking it to the **streets**

Not all health services suit all people: this is a fact well known to anyone who has worked with homeless people.

Homeless people are particularly vulnerable to physical and mental health problems, yet the sad irony is that they are the members of society who often have most difficulty accessing primary health care services. Financial challenges combine with other obstacles — such as information about medical history — to discourage such people from seeking out the medical attention they all too often require.

They also often don’t think about the need to see a GP: they have enough to worry about and so their health is just not a priority.

A program developed by the Perth and Hills Division of General Practice was piloted by Fremantle Regional Division of General Practice (GP Network) with funding from the Australian Department of Health and Ageing. In 2003 funding from the Western Australian Department of Health enabled GP Network to revive the mobile, street-based medical service on the streets of Fremantle.

“The FREO *StreetDoctor* has been on the move, so to speak, ever since. The overwhelming public support, sponsorship offers, and the continued commitment of GP Network ensured the pilot program evolved into an ongoing service for the region’s homeless and other at-risk marginalised people.

“The primary target groups for the FREO *StreetDoctor* mobile service are marginalised and at-risk populations, including homeless people, young people; people with diagnosed and undiagnosed mental illness, Indigenous people, and injecting drug users.

“The FREO *StreetDoctor* operates two evenings a week, in Fremantle, and a few days a week in other parts of Perth, which is enough to make a difference to the primary-care access of some of the city’s most disadvantaged.

“One of the many people who have been assisted by the FREO *StreetDoctor* is Mr Brown (not his real name), a 59-year-old homeless man with a range of health issues.

“Mr Brown first presented with a wound to his knee, but he couldn’t recall how he had fallen. The FREO *StreetDoctor* staff maintained regular contact with Mr Brown, gradually developing a good rapport with him.

“Mr Brown eventually felt comfortable enough with the *StreetDoctor* staff to tell them that he had a problem with his temper, which sometimes resulted in violence, and he was in trouble with the courts.

“Mr Brown’s main health concerns were alcohol abuse, depression and osteoarthritis, and his poor nutrition was also a problem. As part of his court order, Mr Brown had obtained accommodation, but had not coped living in a confined space so had gone back on the streets.”

Thanks to the FREO *StreetDoctor*, Mr Brown was vaccinated for Hepatitis B. As well as ensuring Mr Brown is receiving these important preventative measures, FREO *StreetDoctor* staff have served as a regular source of support. Seeing him often, they have been able to reiterate health messages that will hopefully protect him from many of the serious conditions that commonly afflict homeless people.

Dr Bennie Ng is one of the GPs on the FREO *StreetDoctor* roster. He decided to get involved after seeing a notice sent out by his local division.

"I thought it would be good for me to get in touch with the other side of community that I don't normally see, because I work in areas where the doctors aren't normally going to see the disadvantaged."

"Since I've become involved I've been really surprised at the number of homeless people there are. You never know until you actually do a job like this. You wonder how these people fall through the cracks, and fall through the safety nets, but they do. And of course you realise these people just don't have the same access to medical care."

Dr Ng believe it is crucial homeless people have access to a regular GP, someone who can get to know them well enough to know what health risks they face.

"The FREO *StreetDoctor* is only two days a week, so it can't really take the place of long-term care. But we can be that first point of contact, and we encourage patients to see a regular GP."

"I often think the biggest difference I can make is by gaining [the patient's] trust. If you sit and have a good yarn about what is going on in their lives, they then trust you more and you can talk to them about their health and explains things that can be done and what they can do [health-wise]. If I do this, then I feel like I've done my job," Dr Ng says.

"It is a great initiative because it is really serving a population that GPs don't normally see. And I often think, 'How else would you reach these people?'"



Coached to **better health**

Perhaps everyone could do with a coach sometimes—someone to remind you of the healthy food you should be eating and to walk to the supermarket, not drive. But for people suffering coronary heart disease (CHD), a coach can be more than a luxury; they can be a lifesaver.

The Melbourne Division of General Practice (MDGP) have gone with this idea, and taken the popular hospital based COACH program and placed it in a primary care setting. Under the MDGP's COACH program, patients with coronary heart disease are assigned a 'cardiac coach' who trains and supports them so they can aggressively pursue the targets set by the National Heart Foundation of Australia.

Eligible patients—those with a previous coronary problem, diabetes, or non-coronary vascular disease—are referred to the program by their GP to a cardiac coach, who is usually a dietician, for an initial face-to-face assessment.

During the first session, the coach determines how much their patient know about their risk factors, the targets for these risk factors, and their knowledge and practice of lifestyle measures and drug treatments to prevent and manage CHD. Where gaps in knowledge or behaviour are identified, the coach educates the patient, making it easier for them to achieve their targets.

The coach then works with the patient through bimonthly telephone 'pep talks' to ensure they are sticking to their goals. The process repeats itself at subsequent coaching sessions until all risk factor targets are met.

Since patient recruitment began in January 2004 almost 300 patients have been enrolled in MDGP's COACH program. For patients who have been coached for at least six months there was significant improvement in their cholesterol levels, blood pressure, and activity levels.

A patient survey indicated that participants found the COACH program beneficial to their health in a variety of ways.

One patient stated, "[The COACH program] has changed my life. If not for the COACH program I would not have found out about cholesterol and triglyceride raised levels." Another patient said the program had helped them "recognise and value my condition. I learned how important it is to look after myself."

MDGP Cardiac Coach Lyndsay Burton said the great thing about the program was that it "made patients more proactive about managing their condition".

"It seems the patients are empowered to go to their GPs more and stay informed. The ongoing support of the coach just seems to serve as a real encouragement; they know they have got someone to talk to if they have question", Ms Burton said.

To date, 31 GPs from 27 practices have referred patients into the COACH program. MDGP GP Ines Rio regularly refers patients into the program.

"It is a great opportunity to easily access a dietician who is giving the patient the same fundamental messages about lifestyle modification that you are giving the patient. This enhances care and has resulted in the substantial improvement of the risk factors for many of my patients."

The **leaping lizards** of the Pilbara

The Pilbara Division of General Practice (PDGP) in Western Australia knew it had to do something about the increasing number of children in the region who were overweight.

They were aware of the alarming national statistics (40 per cent of children are overweight or obese and one-quarter of Australians will suffer from diabetes by 2013) and knew that overweight children set themselves up for trouble in later years. Not only are overweight children far more likely to become overweight adults, they are also at greater risk of suffering diabetes, cardiovascular disease and mental illness.

So instead of waiting to deal with the wide range of health problems that are associated with an overweight population, the division decided to grab the bull by the horns and promote physical activity and healthy eating in children. So began the Leaping Lizards initiative.

Sponsored by the Telstra Foundation, Leaping Lizards is a community-orientated program delivered through primary schools in Karratha and Dampier.

Its aim is simple: to increase physical activity and healthy food choices among participating children and their families. By establishing a ‘health-promoting environment’ and healthy lifestyle habits, the program provides the opportunity for participating children to live a healthy childhood, which, it is hoped, will carry through to later life.

Leaping Lizards initiatives to date include the purchase of new physical activity equipment; the establishment of daily fitness programs; ‘fun stations’ at school sports carnivals; promotion of community sporting clubs; parent nutrition workshops and canteen menu modifications; and role model guest speakers, such as visiting Olympic athletes and AFL players, who demonstrate the message that ‘physical activity is fun’.

Launched in 2004, Leaping Lizards has proved an outstanding success. Project officer Geniene Mairata says the response from students, parents and teachers has been extremely positive and supportive.

“Children involved are so enthusiastic about Leaping Lizards. I think it’s because it delivers positive health messages in a variety of fun and innovative ways. And the teachers and canteen staff are enthusiastic because they receive professional development from visiting experts that would otherwise not be offered,” Ms Mariata says.

“The schools have requested ongoing support to overcome the barriers faced in the Pilbara that limit them in their level of activity undertaken in the warmer months.”

Ms Mairata said there was also great support in the wider community for the Leaping Lizards program. “People see the benefits it provides through its consistent and encouraging healthy and happy lifestyle messages and activities.”

Steve Cook, a teacher from a participating primary school, has seen firsthand the difference the program can make.

“Over the past two years Tambrey Primary School has been lucky enough to have the program. During this time the school community has benefited in numerous ways.”

Wonders of the web make a dermatological difference

What does a rural GP do when they are confronted with a patient with a skin disorder, but there isn't a dermatologist for many, many miles?

The answer, thanks to a Queensland Divisions of General Practice (QDGP) initiative, is that they access Tele-Derm, an online resource designed primarily for rural GPs who need advice on the diagnosis and management of skin disease.

Tele-Derm is a joint initiative between QDGP and the Australian College of Rural and Remote Medicine (ACRRM), and is hosted through ACRRM's Rural and Remote Medical Education Online site (RRMEO).

So successful was the program in Queensland that it 'went national' in March this year, funded by the Australian Government Department of Health and Ageing under the Medical Specialist Outreach Assistance Program (MSOAP).

A major factor in the popularity of the program is the up-skilling Tele-Derm provides GPs by increasing their clinical knowledge of skin diseases management.

Through the service, GPs are able to access online dermatological case studies, information about education opportunities, recommended links and discussion forums.

As well as the education aspect, Tele-Derm is a very valuable diagnostic service for GPs in rural and remote areas whose patients are not in a position to access a dermatologist.

Ben Cohn, QDGP's Rural Specialist Support Program Officer, explains how this aspect of the initiative works: "GPs can electronically submit deidentified cases for assessment, complete with digital images of symptoms. These case studies are then investigated by a Brisbane-based dermatologist who provides advice on diagnosis. The cases also remain online for access by other Tele-Derm enrolled GPs."

"It really makes a big difference to the quality of primary care these patients are receiving," Mr Cohn says.

"For rural and remote communities, Tele-Derm is a real saviour for people suffering skin diseases. It means they don't have to travel often long distances, at considerable cost, to see a city dermatologist. Instead, they receive rapid access to dermatological advice from their upskilled local GP."

Indeed, the program has been so successful that QDGP has received letters of praise in the mail from GPs living as far away as remote Northern Territory.

"Some GPs have told us their patients are often receiving advice and treatment more quickly than they would be if they were living in a metropolitan area."

One GP who regularly uses Tele-Derm is Dr Ewen McPhee, who lives and practices in Emerald in Queensland. Located 270km inland from Rockhampton, and 1000km from Brisbane, Emerald is the perfect example of a community that benefits from the Tele-Derm program.

Dr McPhee says he uses Tele-Derm 'extensively, at least once a week'.

He no longer has to refer patients to Brisbane: a major plus for patients because they do not have to travel 1000km for diagnosis and treatment. The advantages are even more obvious when the particular skin condition can be adequately managed by an upskilled

GP working through the web with a specialist dermatologist.

Indeed, one of the benefits of the program is that because of the upskilling, GPs are better able to identify which patients actually need referral to a dermatologist and which can be managed effectively in the primary care setting.

“The educational aspect means that GPs get better at screening patients. There’s research that shows that about 20 per cent of patients referred to a dermatologist don’t need to be; so it is important to give GPs the skills and confidence to manage those patients,” Dr McPhee says.

There are also benefits in terms of improving relationships between GPs and their patients.

“An important aspect of Tele-Derm is that it ensures patients have confidence in their GPs, in as much as they see them working with a specialist to provide a [treatment] outcome in their home town. This obviously improves the relationship you have with patients,” Dr McPhee said.

Tele-Derm is available to all ACRRM members, and currently has more than 600 GPs enrolled. The statistics keep growing, but so far there have been close to 20,000 hits on the website, with an average of about 1000 hits a month from more than 170 GPs. It is the most popular module on the RRMEQ site.

The service has assisted with more than 100 individual cases (via the drop box and discussion forum) and includes approximately 200 interactive cases for GPs to work through at their own pace, enhancing their skills as they go.

Brisbane North DGP has recently completed a three-year coordinated trial of an innovative coordinated care strategy for people with chronic or complex medical conditions.

Under Team Care Health 11, GPs, community nurses, hospitals and other service providers collaborate to manage the health care of people with chronic and complex medical conditions.

Maida Lilley, a 71-year-old who has suffered from chronic arthritis, asthma and diverticulitis, was one of the participants of the program. Maida says she was already happy with her ‘wonderful GP’, so didn’t really think she needed to be involved in the trial, but was happy to ‘give it a go’.

“Although I didn’t think I needed it at first, now I can really see the benefits. I’ve got some wonderful follow-up after I had two joint replacements. I’ve felt thoroughly spoilt!” says Maida.

In the Team Care 11 trial, each patient was given a service coordinator (a community nurse appointed to the practice) who managed their allied health needs. Access to the allied services, such as dietitians and occupational therapists, was free and immediate in the trial, which is often not the case when patients are having to find the help they need on their own. The aim was simple: to address risk factors and prevent hospital admissions.

Two physiotherapists visited Maida at home after her operations. She says it was ‘magic’ having the house visits, and helped her feel on-top of her illness and better able to get on with life.

A ‘persuasive, friendly’ service coordinator made Maida feel like there were a range of options for her to manage her condition. “She was great, really enthusiastic, and talked through different options with me.”

Robert Gan, a GP in the area who was involved in the Team Care 11 trial, says the program confirmed that patients with chronic conditions definitely benefited from allied health services.

“The Team Care 11 trial was really looking at early and timely access [to allied services] to reduce readmissions. And we are confident that the trial will show a reduction in hospital admissions for patients in the intervention group as compared to the control group ... The Team Care 11 approach really seemed to make a difference.”

Dr Gan said his experience with the trial program has resulted in changes in the way he manages his practice and treats patients with chronic and complex conditions.

“Because of the success of the trial, I have incorporated some of the learning in to my own practice,” Dr Gan said.

“I’ve recruited some practice nurses, who work with allied health workers, and I have a greater focus on delivering preventative primary health care before acute or episodic care is needed ... I think it is really important to work in general practice teams, especially with shortages in the medical workforce, and the Team Care 11 trial shows there are real benefits for patients in taking a team-based and preventative approach to treatment.

“It is also a sensible approach in terms of the ageing population, because it reduces the risk of patients requiring urgent home visits or hospital/nursing home admissions.

Walk and talk approach to suicide

The Yorke Peninsula DGP in South Australia has developed an innovative way of tackling the tragic problem of suicide. The program involves community members, health professionals and other service providers and aims to help people cope with stress and life difficulties.

Under the program, which is called ‘If only I knew ... seeking answers together’, all libraries in the areas have been supplied with a special ‘trolley’ containing mental health information packs (with self-help strategies) from beyondblue, and pedometers to encourage people to ‘walk it out, talk it out’.

Hairdressing salons have also been provided with ‘walk it out, talk it out’ fridge magnets and mental health information material.

Program coordinator Jo Pilger said the ‘walk it’ strategy was simple to promote, but it also appeared to be quite a powerful intervention.

“A brisk walk with a friend is a really good way to off-load. It can be a time to share worries and get them in perspective, before they build up and become unmanageable. And the evidence suggests that physical activity does improve mood.

“For all these reasons, we have spread the word that a simple mental health self-help technique is to go for a walk and a good talk with a friend, family member or colleague can really make a difference. So just do it!”

The division also holds regular community seminars, including a support group for those who have lost loved ones to suicide.

As part of the ‘If only I knew ...’ project, the division has facilitated forums for the community and for service providers.

According to program coordinator Jo Pilger, the forums have “enabled community members and organisations to work together to promote resilience and effective help-seeking skills”.

“If only I knew ...” has boosted community awareness about mental health and encouraged service providers to make better use of existing resources,” Ms Pilger says.

Peter Vanderhorst, 30, suffers schizo-affective disorder. He says he heard about the consumers’ forum which forms part of the program—and decided he wanted to be involved.

“I wanted to get to get other people’s views on mental illness and suicide, and express my own views. I wanted to help people going through similar things.”

Peter has lost a friend to suicide, and so knows how important it is for people in trouble to have help at hand. “The ‘If only I knew ...’ program is about working out ways of helping people when they need it.”

The ‘walk it out’ technique was particularly effective, Peter said, and he had used it himself on occasion.

“As it happened, the friend I wanted to go and walk and talk with had a crook back, so it ended up just being a sit and talk it out session. But it was really good just to have someone to talk to, who you could trust.”

The Illawarra Division of General Practice (IDGP) in New South Wales has for the past seven years been working collaboratively with their local media outlets to develop key health messages conveyed on WAVE FM and PRIME Television to households in the Illawarra region.

The IDGP and WAVE FM and PRIME Television have been working together to develop Community Service Announcements (CSAs) focusing on over 20 key health areas pertinent to the local community. The partnership has been so successful, that the division, based in Wollongong, New South Wales, has been recognised by the Prime Minister for its creative partnership approach to health care in the region.

“The partnership has seen local GPs bringing regional health issues to life and presenting them to the homes, work places and even motor vehicles of most Illawarra residents”, said Dr Andrew Dalley, Chief Executive Officer of the IDGP.

The coordinated program has not shied away from controversial messages such as violence against pregnant women and risk taking behaviour in adolescents. The people of the Illawarra now have a greater understanding of the role that GPs and general practice plays in primary health care as a result of the media partnership”, he said.

For their success in this initiative, the IDGP was awarded the New South Wales State Award for Excellence in Community Partnerships in the small business category. The awards are the flagship of the Prime Minister’s Community Business Partnership. They now tough it out with a smaller group of finalists for the national awards to be presented by the Prime Minister in October 2005.

“Being recognised by the Prime Minister’s Community Business Partnerships for this contribution to healthier people in the Illawarra is a bonus”, said Dr Rene Dostal, Chairman of the IDGP. “We derive enormous satisfaction from the media’s willingness to contribute to the well-being of the local community”, he said.

Other examples of the CSAs developed under the partnership include suicide, depression in adolescents, a key program of the Illawarra Division, and obesity in children, also a key focus for Australia’s health professionals. All have focused on promoting the key role that GPs play in supporting people’s health, and creating a healthier community.

Whilst the Illawarra region is an urban setting, it is clear that the successes of this division have been based mainly on its ability to work with general practice and other key stakeholders.

Dr Dostal, who is also a local GP, is enthusiastic about the partnership continuing.

“We are encouraged by the partnership approach that Illawarra GPs have in our region”, said Dr Dostal. “Working as part of a team to help the community with their health care issues is the way to go for general practice now, and well into the future”, he said.

DVD is abreast of issues for young women

A locally produced DVD called ‘Empowering Young Women with Early Breast Cancer’ is a first of its kind because of the way it tackles issues affecting newly diagnosed young women.

The Northern Rivers Division of General Practice (NRDGP) developed the resource that deals with issues head-on, such as the psychosocial impact of breast cancer and the implications for sexuality, body image and fertility.

The DVD was developed by the NRDGP, based in Lismore New South Wales, in partnership with the National Breast Cancer Centre through the Polo Ralph Lauren ‘Pink Pony’ campaign. It targets a real need in the area for local health professionals in providing support and advice to young women, from the perspective of young women.

Local identity and breast cancer survivor, Liz Terracini from the Northern Rivers Performing Arts (NORPA) organisation, who launched the DVD, described the range of emotions and experiences shared by breast cancer sufferers.

“For young women in the past, there wasn’t much information available to assist them in coming to terms with being diagnosed with breast cancer. They needed to rely on the support of family and close friends and do their own research, rather than being able to access quality resources”, Liz said.

“Now, more information is available. A much needed resource such as this 30 minute DVD will be a major help to young women with breast cancer and their partners.”

The DVD was filmed late last year during a one day workshop attended by 40 local young women with breast cancer and their partners. It was part of the Empowering Young Women with Breast Cancer (eYWbc) project, which aimed to address the major issues young women with breast cancer in rural areas face and has also seen the establishment of a local support group for young women with breast cancer.

“We are delighted to be able to bring this DVD resource to young women newly diagnosed with breast cancer and hope it will make the often confusing early days of their diagnosis a little easier to cope with”, said GP, Dr Marc Heyning, who talks in the DVD about some of the issues partners face.

“The DVD has five chapters that reflect the main issues young women grapple with when diagnosed with early breast cancer, such as their sexuality, fertility and psychosocial issues, and their reconstruction options—real stuff that worries young women.

“The DVD is unique in that it brings together both women who have experienced breast cancer first hand with specialists in this field. It gives women a great resource to discuss and explore the impact of their breast cancer with their families, GP, specialists and support group”, Marc said.

The DVD resource is available from GPs, specialists, breast care nurses and the local Cancer Council in Lismore and the surrounding regions. Copies are also available by phoning the division on (02) 6622 4453.
